- We'll kick things off around 12:15 PM, so come hungry and ready to connect!


No charge for lunch, however donations to support the vital work in Rwanda would be welcome.

Finance

The 2024 accounts have been prepared and were agreed by the PCC. They now go to an External Independent Examiner. Overall we recorded a surplus of £5,924 for 2024. If you would like to see or ask anything about the accounts - please contact Ian J Burnham accountant via the church office who will be very pleased to help.

Church Land update- the land occupied by the youth centre, car park and green space.

The PCC and the Parish Council have been working together on an agreed Frequently asked Questions information sheet about the land to be published in Sway News and elsewhere. Once this is available we will circulate it as a separate item to church members by e mail.

The next Church members meeting is arranged for **Wednesday 26th February at 7pm in church.**

We are still waiting for legal advice about a covenant on the land via the Diocese.

Once this legal covenant is available the PCC have then agreed to instruct a specialist surveyor experienced in dealing with church land to provide The PCC with research and reports so they can advise the church on next steps.

The Parish Council are considering their options and will hold an exhibition in the Youth centre in March.

The date for the village meeting for all about the Church Land is **April 9th 7pm in Church.**
