The PCC set the dates this week for the **fundraising campaign for the RAINWATER GOODS.** This job is to replace the guttering and downpipes that caused the damp in the first place.... The campaign will run for 6 weeks from **6th Oct to 17th November** with a target of raising **£30,000** for the new rainwater goods work and an additional **£20,000** to replenish reserves used for the building maintenance work just finished

The diocese are working hard to set up our giving page and online donation account more details soon! There is £10,000 of match funding for the first £10,000 raised that will help us on our way. Love in a Box Filled shoe boxes as Christmas gifts for under privileged children in Eastern Europe.



It's the time of year to appeal to you to support and donate to Love in a Box. Janet and the team in Sway have been organising this project for 31 years now and last year 258 boxes were sent off, which is the most they have ever done. Let's try and help to

match this and even better it this year.

It is for a wonderful cause allowing schools, businesses, churches and other organisations and individuals to fill shoe boxes with gifts for under privileged children throughout Eastern Europe who would otherwise not receive a Christmas present. Each one is individually received by a child.

It is a whole village project and so many people are involved. There are leaflets with suggestions of what to put in the boxes at the back of church, in the church rooms, the hub, the post office or from Janet at Hillside, Middle Road.

How can I help?

You can help by either filling a box (covered ones are available from Janet or in the church rooms), giving items for the team to pack into boxes or by donating money to help with post and packaging and also towards buying items we need. **The closing date is November 8th.**
