Christmas card deliveries Thank you to the wonderful volunteers. All the cards have been delivered in good time - over 1000.


MESSY CHRISTINGLE AT 9.30am on Sunday 15th December

They hope it will be the start of something special for their church in Cuenca too!

Next year they are making plans to visit the UK and USA but have decided to combine their time away, Bev going to the UK and Johnny to USA, which will save time away from the church and also save on their budget too. Bev will be in the New Forest in July and a visit to Sway, Everton and Milford would be her plan for the weekend 19th-20th July.
