

## CHURCH YOUTH CENTRE LAND UPDATE

The Parish Council asked for a direction of travel from the church by the 30th June regarding the youth centre land as the lease expires in 4 years time. The PCC have responded to the Parish Council as follows:

The view of the church is that the land should continue to be used for community use in connection with the mission of church. (other options are not therefore being considered)

There is very little support from the church for selling the freehold of the land so this is very unlikely.

The church is indicating strong support to keep the existing building - this honours those who donated money for it, it is a good eco option and the building is in better condition that previously thought.

The church has been generous in the past supporting the village and wants to continue to be generous - the task now is to wait for our professional advice and comply with charity law and consider the options for providing ongoing community use with as little disruption to current users as possible. There will be ongoing discussions with the Parish Council about how this might work if they were to renew the lease.
